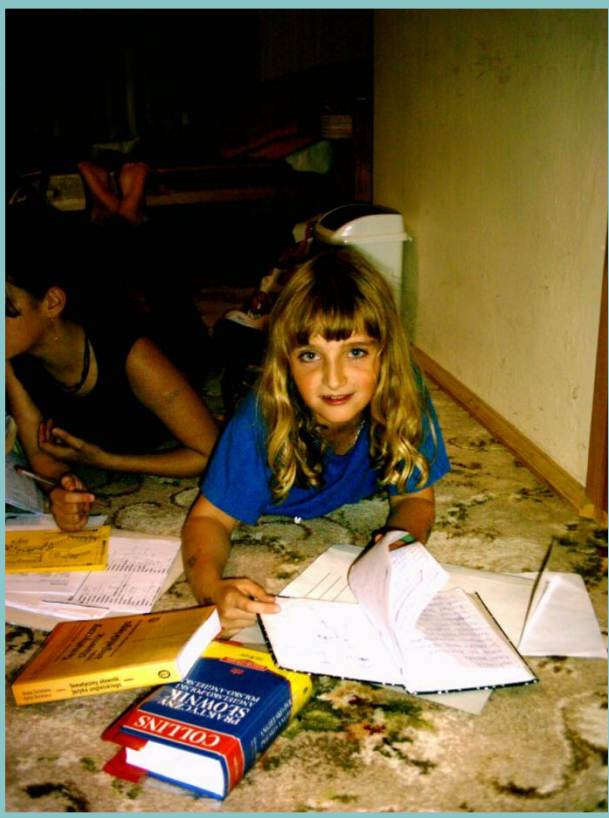

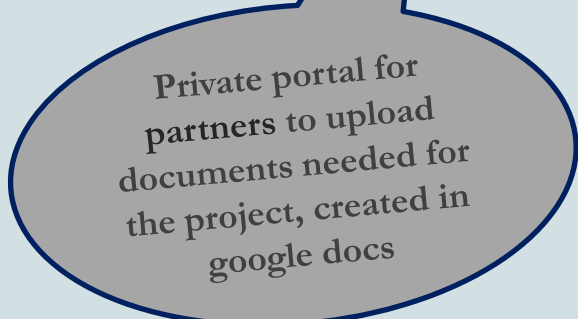


WE ARE HERE ...

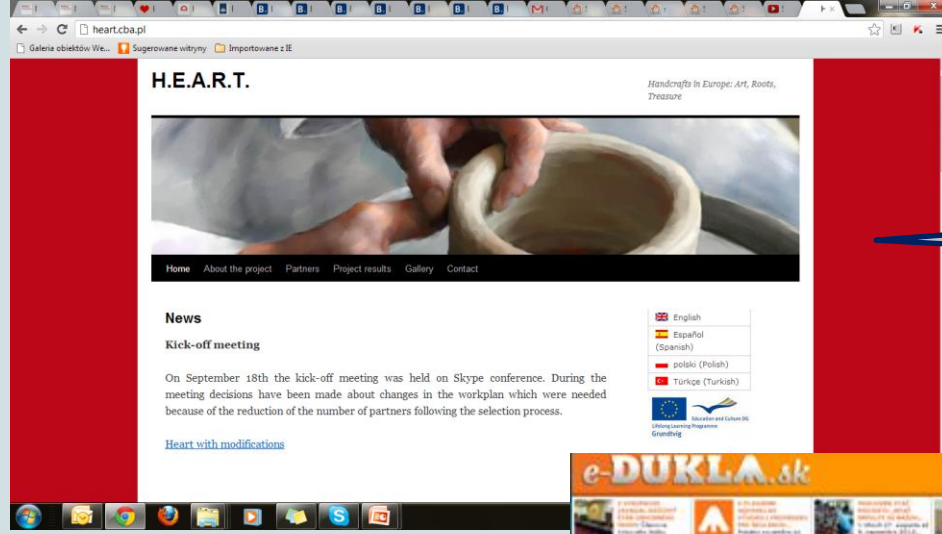
